



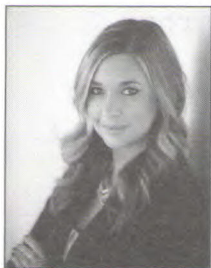

Do you think I'm too "controversial"?

Dear Friend,

If you've watched me co-host the daytime show "Outnumbered" on Fox News or guest co-host "Fox and Friends" and "The Five," then you know I don't ever apologize for my conservative values and constitutional rights.

I own a gun and know how to use it.

I believe President Trump is leading this country in the right direction.

And I'm proud of America... not ashamed!

But there are millions of young Americans who hold these same values... but are too scared to say them out loud.

Why are they so intimidated?

Because they're students in high schools and on college campuses where free speech you and I take for granted is under vicious attack.

Where just wearing a red "Make America Great Again" hat or saying you believe there are only two genders can get you punched in

the nose or kicked out of the classroom.

I should know -- just ten years ago I was a young, impressionable college student at the University of Arizona.

It didn't take me long to realize that my teachers didn't just dislike the conservative values my parents had instilled in me... they hated them.

My professors relied on MSNBC and CNN as the "gold standard" when it came to presenting the "truth" in their classes.

But I had no idea they'd try to silence my voice until I got involved with a national conservative group called **Young America's Foundation (YAF)**.

With YAF's support, I decided to invite conservative author and activist **David Horowitz** to speak on our campus.

He had just written a book about "how radical professors at America's top colleges indoctrinate students and undermine our democracy."

And I was about to discover just how right he was!

Just two days before the lecture the school threatened to shut it down unless our campus group coughed up cash to pay for "security" because administrators had deemed the lecture "controversial."

Meanwhile, campus activists tore down

our signs and posters advertising the event so students wouldn't know about it.

Then, just three hours before the start of the event, the school moved the lecture to a hidden-away classroom in the hopes that no one would show up.

Yet despite every road block they threw at us, the event was a huge success.

University of Arizona students got to hear David Horowitz explain why capitalism and conservatism are the true roots of freedom.

And I learned a valuable lesson:

The Left will do anything to prevent young people from hearing from conservatives because they know that students who hear the truth about our values will reject socialism.

Oh, you won't hear much about the threats, violence and intimidation pointed at conservatives on college campuses from the mainstream media.

But I've witnessed it firsthand.

You see, YAF had such an impact on my life that today I'm one of their speakers.

And I personally know how enraged the far-Left can get when we speak up for commonsense values that used to be taken for granted -- such as border security, free

enterprise, and traditional family values.

For example:

*** **When I spoke at the University of Wisconsin, radical campus activists protested my speech by committing an obscene act that should have been treated as sexual harassment.** Instead, the university ignored the protestors, labeled me "controversial" and imposed a "security fee" on the local YAF chapter.

*** **And at Kennesaw State University in Georgia, campus administrators tried to prevent me from speaking.** Claiming I was "controversial," campus administrators tried to force the local YAF chapter to pay a heavy handed "security fee" in a clear effort to stifle free speech.

But I'm not the only one who's had to deal with this kind of intimidation.

** **Ben Shapiro** was threatened with arrest if he stepped on campus at DePaul University.

** **Dinesh D'Souza** had stink bombs let off during his speech by protestors at Stanford.

** And at the University of Missouri - Kansas City, a campus radical attacked **Michael Knowles** with an unknown white liquid substance.

My friend, the First Amendment says that

every American deserves to have their voice heard in the public square.

Everyone deserves a chance to share their opinion and defend their viewpoints.

But the Left is terrified of your ideas.

Just as light exposes darkness, YAF speakers expose the lies of the Left.

That's why the Left would rather silence our voices instead of debate us.

And they will get away with it unless American patriots like you and me stand up for the Constitution and freedom.

I've heard many good people say it's too late... there's nothing we can do to stop the Left from indoctrinating young people on college campuses with socialism.

But YAF is living proof we CAN stop them!

Free speech triumphed when Young America's Foundation sued Kennesaw State and achieved a major legal victory that will ensure what happened to me won't happen to other conservative speakers there.

Free speech triumphed again when YAF sued the University of California, Berkeley for discriminating against Ben Shapiro and other conservative speakers trying to speak on campus. YAF won again -- forcing UC - Berkeley to stop their unconstitutional
